- 3-Read *What Kind of Unity and The New United Church of Christ and the Ecumenical Movement* by Dr. Maxfield.
- 4-Make a list of ecumenical and interfaith activities in which your congregation participates. This will be submitted as part of your project.
- 5-Prepare and submit an essay of your reflections in the document *Christianity and Other Religions*. What new insights do these reading give you? Explain your perspective. Your paper is to be 1-3 pages, 1-inch margins, double-spaced and handed in the day of the class.
